FMRS activities

- Collaboration with NASA (co-chairing MedRIN, NASA's network covering the Eastern Mediterranean – in collaboration with the Cyprus University of Technology).
- Partner of the Global Wildfire Information System (GWIS) - the GEO initiative on Remote Sensing of forest fires.
- Represents Greece in EARSeL for the period 2018 - 2022. Also chairs the EARSeL Special Interest Group on Forest Fires (EARSeL – FFSIG) since 2010.
- National focal point for the FAO Forest Resources Assessment - Remote Sensing Survey.
- Member of the UN-FAO Global Observation of Forest and Land Cover dynamics (GOFC GOLD) Fire Implementation Team.
